

Swedish Open PPC

St. Olof 10-13 August 2017

On behalf of the Swedish Shooting Federation SPSF the clubs of the southern region hereby invite international shooters to Sweden and Swedish Open in PPC 2017.

Place for competition is Österlens Pistolklubbs shooting range in St. Olof, South of Sweden (90 km from Malmö). GPS coordinates: WGS 84: 55°38'43.8"N 14°8'34.9"E. Webpage for competition www.ppcsm2017.se

Time: Prematch is shot Wednesday and Thursday 9-10th of August. Main match starts Thursday 10th at noon and will end on Sunday 13th of August. For shooters with access to login at www.ppc1500.se you can enter your starts at the event that is published in the competition calendar. For shooters without login you can either request the login or **send your application to anmalan@ppcsm2017.se** and we will enter your starts in the schedule. There is a separate shooting range for training – open all days from 08:00 to 18:00 during the competition.

Application needs to be sent to administrator before 2017-07-01.

Payment can be done either at site or as bank transfer. You will receive details when you send your application.

Fee: 1500-match: 220 SEK, 60-match: 150 SEK, 48-match: 100 SEK. Team match 100 SEK.

Team match is match 5 in 1500 main match.

Classes: High Master, Master, Expert, Sharpshooter och Marksman

Prices: To position 1-3 in every class in all matches and price to the overall Winner in every Match. Lottery prices according to standard procedure. Price ceremony starts approx. 16:00 on Sunday 13th.

Rules: According to latest rules book from WA1500. No pistols to be holstered chambered. Gun control to be made when you get your score sheets.

Food: Lunch will be served at the shooting range all days. Sandwiches, sausage, cookies and beverages will be served all day during all competition days. There is also a banquet on Saturday evening – with a 3-course dinner incl. drinks (wild boar barbeque). Check with us if you would like to attend – price is 400 SEK.

Accommodation: There are plenty of camping sites, hostels and hotels in the region. They do get fully booked quickly so make sure you book in time. If you have a caravan och mobile home you will be able to have it close to the shooting range for a small fee (electricity will be available). The space is limited and with access to toilet (no shower – there is a municipal bath you can go to just 3 km from the range).

We are looking forward to seeing a lot of international shooters at Swedish Open.
