



## Travelling with firearms

### Germany

#### EU – Citizens

(up top 6 firearms per person. By more firearms you have to act as a Non EU citizen)

#### Documents:

ID card  
European Firearms Permit (valid)  
Invitation or Registration to competition or practice

#### Procedure:

Travelling by car without any restrictions  
There are special procedures by using aircraft and ferry  
you may have to inform yourself  
Travelling by railway is illegal

#### Non EU – Citizens

#### Documents:

Application for temporary entrainment of firearms (§ 32 (4) WaffG)  
ID card  
National Firearms License  
Certificate of non-objection by police or statement under oath, that there are no police-reports about one-self  
Invitation to competition or practice

#### Procedure:

The participant sent scans from the documents above as .pdf- files to the responsible in Germany named by the host of the competition by e-mail  
The responsible in Germany sent the scans to the responsible authority  
The authority sent the permissions to the host of the match by mail  
The host sent scans of the permissions to the participant  
The participant has to carry the permission with him for control by police  
The firearms are to declare by crossing the German border  
The host hand out the original permission  
The host will pay the fee to the authority in time  
The participant will pay the fee during the competition to the host
